

The School reopened on the 1st of June with an initiation programme in which the new students were welcomed into the Nirmalite community. The light of knowledge was symbolically passed on to the teachers and student representatives of the classes by the newly charged principal Sr. Linsa Maria SABS after invoking the blessings of the Almighty for the year that lay ahead. The academic session started on a jubilant note with 100% success in the class X and class XII Board examinations. All the 252 candidates who appeared for the class XII examinations passed in the first class with 29 students securing A1 in all subjects. Jeswin C Joshy topped the list with 97.4% of marks. Centum was scored by 6 students in Biology and 5 in Maths. In Class X out of 137 students Irene Biju topped with 99% marks and All India 3rd rank. 57 students secured 90% above.

The school received trophies for cent percent success in Class X and XII examinations from the Thrissur Corporation and the Arch Diocese of Thrissur for the 21st consecutive years.

Various programmes are conducted in the school starting with the question of the day which will be asked in the Assembly for which students will write the answers in a paper and put it in a box. The prizes will be distributed for the lucky students.
