

Assessment pattern

The assessment and examination for classes VI to VIII comprises of two terms . i.e Term 1 and Term 2. The evaluation pattern for class IX will be similar to that of class X with a single term. The assessment structure comprises of two areas

- Scholastic area: - This includes three Periodic tests, Half Yearly Examination (for VI-VIII), Annual Examination, Note Book Submission and Subject Enrichment Activities.
- Co Scholastic Area: - For the holistic development of the student, cocurricular activities will be graded in Work Education, Art Education, Health & Physical Education. 3..
- In addition to the above, the students will also be assessed for Discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behavior, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others. School strictly implements “No homework policy” for classes I and II

BEST PRACTICES OF THE SCHOOL

- Students who experience difficulty in learning various subjects are identified and extra coaching (Remedial coaching) is provided after school hours.
- Students are encouraged to appear for various inter-school competitive examination
- Question banks are prepared for various subjects for the students of Std I-VIII and 30% of the questions will be taken to support the students with learning disability.
- Classwise theme based assembly is conducted to ensure maximum participant of students in various on-stage programmes and to develop leadership skills.
- To ensure the involvement of students in maintaining discipline, class teachers and health inspectors are entrusted with the duties of checking the uniform, personality, hygiene ,punctuality and eating habits while the students are within the campus .
- Observation and celebration of National and International important days with maximum student participation.
- Field trips are organised every year for the students of all age groups to provide first hand knowledge and experience in various fields.
- Seminars led by experts in different disciplines are organised for the students of Std 9 & 12.
- To install the value of compassion and sense of social commitment , students along with faculty members visit various charitable organisations like orphanages, old age homes etc.
- Students organise entertainment programme for the inmates.
- Students are encouraged to contribute time and wealth to help the lesser privileged members of our society.
- Hridya Project has been installed to complete 25 cardiac surgeries within the year 2018.
- Gifted students have been selected and according to their interest extra coaching in different subjects is given.
- To strengthen the rapport between teachers and parents different activities have been conducted.
- Student Protection group (SPG) is very active in the school campus.
